

Lake City Community Farmers' Market

Rules & Regulations

June – September 2017

Tuesdays 4-6 pm on the Town Square in Lake City

Statement of Purpose: The Lake City Community Farmers' Market exists in order to improve the quality of rural life in the Lake City area by encouraging the production and marketing of local farm and garden products, and by stimulating public interest in the consumption of local farm and garden produce, homemade foods, and craft items.

The market will begin promptly at 4pm on designated Tuesdays. The market will be held rain or shine. No market activity, such as sacking of produce, is to begin until the market manager signals the start of the market.

Any home or market gardener, farmer, baker, or artist with homegrown/homemade products produced in Iowa may rent a stall at the market. Stalls will be assigned by the market manager.

Stall rental fees for the 2017 market season:

1 week	\$6.00
6 weeks	\$25.00 (weeks do not have to be consecutive)
Season (14 weeks)	\$45.00

"Not for profit" organizations pay the same fees as other vendors.

Fees may be paid in advance to Lake City Farmers' Market or paid on market day to the market manager.

Vendors who pay the season fee in advance may reserve a stall location for the entire season.

Vendors may begin setting up their stalls at 3:30 pm. All-season vendors have reserved stalls. All others stalls will be assigned each week on a first-come, first-served basis. Parking spaces are available for those wanting to sell directly from or behind their vehicles. Vendors will keep their stall space clean during the market and will leave it clean at the end of the day.

All products sold at the market must be grown, produced or handmade by the vendor unless otherwise authorized by the market manager. No resale of products is allowed, and no out-of-state products are allowed.

The market manager is the ultimate authority at the market. Any problems should be directed in a polite and timely manner to the manager. The manager's decision will be honored.

Other than dogs, no animals of any kind are permitted in the market area. Dogs are permitted provided they are leashed and strictly controlled. The market manager has the authority to ask the owner of a badly behaved dog to take the animal out of the market area.

No alcohol or other drugs may be used/consumed in the market area (except for tasting wine or beer if a wine or beer vendor is present). No smoking in the market area.

Vendors who do not abide by market rules may be denied the right to sell at the Lake City Community Farmers' Market.
